

2. Remove the factory airbox lid, and set it aside.






3. Remove the factory air filter, and set it



1. <u>Disconnect negative battery cable.</u> Unlatch three clips that hold down the factory airbox lid.



4. Install the Airaid Premium Filter (#1) on the factory tube inside the airbox. Make sure the hose clamp and filter, are tight against the wall of the airbox, and tighten the clamp.



5. Assemble the Quick Fit panels (#2) using the four 6-32x5/16" screws (#5), #6 washers (#7), and nuts (#6).



6. Install the Quick Fit panels by inserting the tab on the front of the panel into the front slot of the factory airbox base (A), and then rotating the panels counterclockwise.



7. Make sure the second tab is aligned in the rear slot of the factory airbox, and then adjust the Quick Fit panels to fit squarely on top of the airbox, and then relatch the three factory clips.



8. Install the provided weather strip (#4) on the top of the Quick Fit panels. For ease of installation, start next to the fender and work your way towards the front of the vehicle.



9. Congratulations on installing your new intake system! See the back of this page for further instructions.

10. Double check your work!


Make sure there is no foreign material in the intake path. Make sure all clamps, hoses, bolts, and screws are tight.


11. Reconnect the negative battery cable!

WARNING! If your vehicle has a Vehicle Emission Control Information decal affixed to the factory airbox, a new replacement label must be obtained and installed in a readily visible position in the engine compartment in order to remain CARB compliant. Failure to do so will prevent the vehicle from passing a smog check. Replacement labels can be ordered from your local dealership. Regulations state that the VECI label shall not be affixed to any equipment which is easily detached from the vehicle. Label placement, under the hood on a painted surface is recommended.
