INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

- Park vehicle on clean, flat, and level surface. Block the wheels for safety. It is best to install this kit with the vehicle on the ground.
- Support the driveshaft and remove the two bolts that attach the carrier bearing to the cross member.
- 3. Lower the carrier bearing so that the drive shaft is in line through the carrier bearing. Install the spacers that get this spacing correct. Attach with new 10mm fully threaded bolts. A general starting place would be ¼" of carrier bearing drop for every 1" of additional lift in the rear. Tighten to 35 ft-lbs.
- 4. Test drive vehicle and ensure there is no vibration. Additional adjustment may be required.
- 5. Check hardware after 500 miles.
