Periodically check all hardware for tightness.

## INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

1. Jack up the rear of the vehicle and place on jack stands. Remove the rear wheels.
2. **NOTE: If this kit is being installed with an existing air spring, leave the air spring installed to the upper mount but remove the lower mount from the air spring.**  
**If this kit is being installed with a new air spring, follow the instructions for installing the upper mount and assembling the air spring components, but do not install the lower mount to the air spring.**
3. Install the cradle to the lower mount with the supplied 3/8" x 1-1/4" bolt, nut, and washer using two 9/16" sockets/wrenches.  
**NOTE: The lower mount may need a hole drilled with a 13/32" drill bit if there is not a hole already.**  
**If so, align the cradle with the air springs, mark through the center hole in the cradle using a paint pen, remove the cradle, and drill.**
4. Reinstall wheels and lower.

**NOTE: The Upper Mount may look different depending on vehicle.**





Upper Mount
