
### NOTE: Installation of this kit requires drilling holes in the front fenders

#### **INSTALLATION:**

Step 1: Place the vehicle on a flat, level surface and engage the parking brake. Place blocks both in front of and behind the rear wheels. Place your floor jack under the front axle and raise vehicle. Place jack stands under the frame rails behind the front wheel wells and lower the frame onto the stands. Remove the jack and remove the front wheels.

Step 2: Unplug the OE fender marker light wiring connector.

Step 3: Working on one side of the vehicle at a time, remove the 6mm OE bolts and OE plastic retainers securing the plastic front fender flare and inner fender liners to the front fender. Save the 6mm bolts for reinstallation. (Fig. A)



Step 4: At this point the plastic front fender flare will be loose. Carefully pull and/or pry to remove the **OE** body clips. Once the plastic front fender flare is removed, remove the remaining body clips from the front fender. (Fig. B)



Step 5: Remove the OE plastic front inner fender liner from the vehicle.

Step 6: Install the inner fender support bracket (93-326EP027 drvr and 93-326EP028 pass) to the (3 per side) existing mounting holes in the core support of the vehicle using the previously removed (3 per side) OE 6mm bolts. (Fig. C)





Step 7: Carefully, test fit the front tube fender flare (93-326EP007 drvr and 93-326EP008 pass) by hanging them in place and installing a few 5/16" X 1" button head bolts and hardware in the existing holes. Be sure to apply the supplied blue threadlocker on the 5/16" bolts. (Fig. D)



Step 8: Once the fender is properly aligned, clamp the lower rear corner of front tube fender flare (93-326EP007 drvr and 93-326EP008 pass) to the OE front fender. (Fig. E)





<u>Step 9:</u> Using the (2) rear lower holes in the front tube fender flare (93-326EP007 drvr and 93-326EP008 pass) as a guide, center punch and drill through the OE front fender using a 5/16" drill bit. (Fig. F)



Step 10: Secure the (2) rear lower holes in the front tube fender flare (93-326EP007 drvr and 93-326EP008 pass) using the supplied 5/16" X 2 1/2" bolt, short lower fender spacer (90-326EP057) and hardware in the lower hole and the supplied 5/16" X 4" bolt, long lower fender spacer (90-326EP047) and hardware in the upper hole. Be sure to apply the supplied blue threadlocker on the 5/16" bolts. (Fig. G)




Step 11: Install the remaining 5/16" X 1" button head bolts and hardware into the remaining mounting holes. Be sure to apply the supplied blue threadlocker on the 5/16" bolts.

Step 12: Torque the tube fender flare mounting 5/16" hardware to ?? ft./lbs.



Step 13: Push the 3/4" Amber LED marker light (R0701GWA1) into the mounting holes in the front tube fender flare (93-326EP007 drvr and 93-326EP008 pass). (Fig. H)

Step 14: Cut and strip the OE side marker light wiring harness. Splice the 3/4" Amber LED marker light (R0701GWA1) wiring into the OE side marker light wiring harness. (90-40647).

NOTE: All electrical wire connections should be soldered and properly insulated.

NOTE: Use wire ties secure the wiring and to route it away from all moving parts.

NOTE: If the 3/4" Amber LED marker light does not work when the lights are turned on, switch the polarity of the (2) wires.

Step 15: Repeat the previous steps on the remaining side of the vehicle.

**Step 16:** Reinstall the front wheels and lower the vehicle to the ground. Torque the wheels to manufacturer's specifications.

Step 17: Installation is now complete.
